ACTING MAYOR MOSENA WELCOMES TWO(2) WATER PROJECTS FROM CAPRICORN DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY

Today, August 25, Blouberg Local Municipality Acting Mayor, Cllr Dan Mosena, welcomed two(2) water supply projects from the Capricorn District Municipality(CDM) for the communities of Mohlabeng wa Malokela and Silvermine.

The Malokela Bognafarm water supply project which will cost the district municipality over R24m commenced today, August 25 and is expected to be completed and supply water to the community by February 25, 2024. Twenty-five(25)jobs have been created.

SCOPE OF WORK | Equipping and electrification of three boreholes. Construction of approximately 11,700m of uPVC pipelines which consists of the bulk water supply and reticulation with different diameters. Installation of ninety standpipes. Installation of a new 150,00kl elevated steel tank. Installation of 100,00kl grounded stacked steel tank. Installation of water treatment package plant.

Construction of brine water ponds. Fencing of boreholes, storage facilities and water purification package plant with palisade steel fence.

The district municipality handed the second water project valued at over R5m to the community of Silvermine.

The project commenced today, August 25, 2023 and scheduled to be completed by February 24, 2024.

SCOPE OF WORK | Sitting, drilling and testing of one borehole. Equipping and electrification of one borehole.

Construction of approximately 1,500m of uPVC pipelines which consists of the bulk water supply and reticulation with different diameters. Installation of ten standpipes. Installation of a new 150,00kl elevated steel tank. Fencing of boreholes and storage facilities with palisade steel fence.

The project created ten(10) temporary job opportunities to locals.
