

KGATLA REGRAVELLING AND STORM WATER CONTROL PROJECT LAUNCHED

The Kgatla village access road in Ward 06 that gets flooded during rainy seasons, denying residents movement out of the village is getting a fix.

Blouberg Local Municipality Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga has today, April 23, performed sod-turning and introduced a contractor for Ga-Kgatla Access Road road project to the community. The regravelling and stormwater water control project of the 4km road is set to commence in May and will be completed within four (4) months.

Mayor Thamaga indicated that the Kgatla project will be implemented as part of disaster relief programme.

" We are happy that we are able to assist the residents of Ga-Kgatla. We have received many numerous calls from community members during rainy seasons indicated that children are unable to go to school, service providers are unable to access the area to delivery food for our learners as well as emergency vehicles not able to assist our patients in times of need."

Mayor Thamaga indicated that with the 47milliom the municipality received as additional funding for disaster relief, municipality has channelled funds to Kgatla Access Road project, Sefihlampsyana, Pickum and Mochemi Access road projects.

The Kgatla project will be implemented at a cost of R4.9million.Fifteen(15) temporary jobs for locals; thirteen(13)general work, One(1) Safety Representative and one(1) Community Liaison Officer(CLO).
