MEC LERULE-RAMAKHANYA HANDS OVER CONTRACTOR FOR THE COMPLETION OF CAPRICORN NORTH EDUCATION DISTRICT OFFICES PROJECT IN SENWABARWANA

Today, Limpopo Education MEC, Ms. Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya spent the better part of her day, April 16, in Blouberg, launching two crucial projects; a multi-million rands construction project as well as the Limpopo School Democracy Programme.

MEC Lerule-Ramakhanya earlier today, handed over the contractor for the completion of the Capricorn North Education District offices project in Senwabarwana.The district office project was left incomplete in 2011.

The MEC announced that, her department has set aside R45.8million budget to complete offices that will soon be utilized and create job opportunities. The construction work which is scheduled for eighteen(18months) is expected to commence in May 2024 and be completed and handed over by December 30, 2025.

The scope of work includes; de-bushing of the area, Completion of fence/wall, completion of electrical work, partitioning of offices, the floor covering with tiles, paving around the yard, Finishes on the roofing and paint work, instalation of air-conditioners, ablution facility, drilling of a borehole and supply of office furniture among others.

Blouberg Local Municipality Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga has extended her gratitude to MEC Ramakhanya for listening to the plight of Blouberg people to have the building completed an put to use."

After so many years the building will be completed and utilised and our people will get jobs. Upon handing over the contractor, MEC Ramakhanya called on municipal and community leaderhip to work together ensuring that the project is implemented without delays.

Our teams will need support from the municipality and we ask that they get the necessary support they will need to complete the required processes.We are doing all this for the people.This is service to our people".
