It has come to our attention that, a certain man claiming to be Vincent Sebola (BLM official)has been calling unsuspecting service providers and prospective bidders asking them to send money through e-wallet service in return for the awarding of a tender. The fraudster would then request that the service providers meet up with him at the municipal headquarters in Senwabarwana to collect their "appointment letters". That being the case, four unsuspecting service providers showed up at the municipality yesterday, March 14, to collect their "appointment letters".

Blouberg Local Municipality has a very sound and transparent tender system. Municipal tenders are advertised on the municipal website and newspapers.

Members of the public are adviced to disregard any further communication in this regard. Those who have already paid the money to the scammer are encouraged report the matter to the nearest police station.
