CONSTRUCTION OF PINKIE SEBOTSE SPORT COMPLEX PROGRESSING WELL

Construction of the new Pinkie Sebotse Sport Complex at Pinkie Sebotse Village in Ward 21 is progressing well. The members of Blouberg Local Municipality Executive Committee(EXCO)conducted a site visit to track the progress on the project. The facility is at 80% completion with some minor construction processes to be completed to meet the 6months deadline next month(August).

The project is part of the municipality's Municipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) funded by the Department of Sport, Arts and Culture.

Launched by the Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga on February 15, the project includes the construction of a soccer field with artificial grass, a grandstand, athletic tracks, ablution facility and change rooms, construction of combi courts (netball, volleyball, basketball and tennis), indigenous games platform, outdoor gym equipment and kids play area among other items on scope of work.
