

BLM COUNCIL HOLDS FIRST MEETING FOR 2025/26 FINANCIAL YEAR The Blouberg Local Municipality Council today, July 30, successfully held its first Ordinary Council meeting for the new financial year 2025/26 at Ga-Machaba, Ward 11. The Council dealt with reports on the Forth Quarter Service Delivery and Budget Implementation Plan(SDBIP) 2024/25, Fourth Quarter Back to basics 2024-25, Draft Intergrated Development Plan - IDP Process plan 2025-26 and the Establishment of solar plant on remainder of farm Bochum 178 LS among others. Delivering the keynote address, the Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga was thrilled to share with the council how the municipality has handled its finances properly in accordance with the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA).
