

MAYOR LAUNCHES FESTIVE SEASON ARRIVE ALIVE CAMPAIGN

The Mayor of Blouberg Local Municipality, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga, officially launched the festive season road safety campaign in Senwabarwana, urging motorists and the community to collaborate in promoting safe driving practices during the holidays.
