

## MAYOR LAUNCHES THE REHABILITATION PROJECT FOR SENWABARWANA CDB STREETS

Potholes in the Senwabarwana central business district will soon be a thing of the past. This is after the Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga conducted a groundbreaking ceremony to mark the official commencement of the construction of Senwabarwana Internal Streets and Stormwater Control Phase 1 project. The project has been budgeted for R20 343 660.89 and is scheduled to run for six(6) months.

### SCOPE OF WORK SUMMARY

- \* Site Clearance
- \* Rehabilitation of base layer - 977m
- \* Laying of 80mm Paving blocks 2370m
- \* Laying of pre-cast concrete kerbs
- \* Laying of 60mm Paving blocks (side walk)
- \* Construction of openlined drains ( V -drain and Trapezoidal drain with the bottom width of 1m and top width of 4m and 1m deep)- 400m.
- \* Construction of 1200mm diameter 100D stormwater pipeline with inlet and outlet structure- 520m
- \* Construction of 900mm diameter 100D stormwater pipeline with inlet and outlet structures - 240m
- \* Construction of 750mm diameter 100D stormwater pipeline with inlet and outlet structures- 80m
- \* Construction of 600mm diameter 100D stormwater pipeline with inlet and outlet structures- 460m
- \* Surface overlay (fog spray) - 1690m
- \* Patchworks (Edge breaks) - 520m
- \* Road signs and Markings
- \* Finishing of the road and clearing site
- \* Construction of Kerbs inlets
- \* Construction of traffic circle and,  
Construction of a bridge- 2X ( 2x 1500 x 1200).
