

REGRAVELLING OF DANTZIG ACCESS ROAD, RECONSTRUCTION OF STORMWATER RETENTION POND AND STORMWATER CONTROL PROJECT LAUNCHED

The Dantzig access road which gets flooded during rainy seasons, denying residents easy access is getting a fix. Today, November 28, 2024, Blouberg Local Municipality Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga conducted a sod-turning ceremony marking the commencement of the Regraveling of Dantzig access road, Reconstruction of stormwater retention pond and stormwater control project.

The project will be implemented at a cost of R5.7million and is set to be completed in six (6) months.

Scope of works:.

- *Reconstruction of stormwater retention pond
- *Regraveling of a 3km Access Road
- *Construction of concrete portal and pipe culverts
- *Stormwater erosion protection

Fifteen(15) temporary jobs for locals; thirteen(13)general work, One(1) Safety Representative and one(1) Community Liaison Officer(CLO) have been created.

The Mayor was accompanied by Council Speaker, Cllr Blanco Boloka and Community Services Chairperson, Cllr Shirley Raphasha.
