

MAYOR CONGRATULATES BLOUBERG SCHOOLS FOR WINNING CASHBUILD BUILDING MATERIAL VOUCHERS

Eight(8)primary schools in Blouberg Local Municipality were today each awarded R15 000 worth of Cashbuild building material for winning the Art-at-Heart competition.
