

SENWABARWANA SPORT COMPLEX OFFICIALLY OPENED

Today(30/10/2),The Blouberg Local Municipality - BLM Mayor, Her Worship Cllr Maria Thamaga officially opened the multi-use state-of-the-art Senwabarwana Sport Complex in Senwabarwana town for young people in Blouberg. According to the Mayor, the sport facility will address the lack of activities and sporting opportunities for young people in Blouberg and support the Council's ambitions for sport development.

"The Council took a resolution to construct the facility after identifying the lack of places and good quality facilities for the children to engage in youth activities, stay active, and participate in sport. The opening of this facility reaffirms the Council's commitment to using our assets to invest in the community and utilising sport to bring about positive change for young people. We will work closely with community partners in sport and recreation to ensure the utilization of sport and physical activity to support young people's personal and social development, as well as their physical and mental health and wellbeing".

This project was constructed in five(5) stages and comprises; a soccer field with artificial grass, netball court, tennis court, volleyball ball court, athletic tracks, gymnasium, boxing building and offices among other items on work scope.

The Mayor thanked all the teams that were involved including councillors, officials and contractors in helping to bring this fantastic facility to fruition.
