# THE KEYNOTE ADDRESS

**W**e cannot wait to express our appreciation of the various structures and stakeholders that warmly welcomed us into office since our election in November 2008. We have been inspired and would want to repay your confidence in us with excellence in performance and results. We are not blind to challenges relative to the sudden change, but with your support the war is half won. The first three months of the new Political Management Team in office has been characterized by hard work, dedication and commitment to serve the community of Blouberg. It could not be business as usual given the bad publicity that had come to characterize our Municipality. Our first programme was to interact and revive confidence in the Municipality among key stakeholders including traditional authorities; youth council; farmers union; church organizations; taxi associations and municipal employees. Subsequent to these interactions we developed an approach to respond to challenges raised during the engagements. We are confident all will soon be well.

One of our first priorities is to put our policies and plans into action. We can't afford to delay one more day. We have immediately given shape to one of our key objectives and constitutional mandate which is to create an environment for local economic growth and job creation, focusing on the competitive advantages of the Municipality. By the time this newsletter hits the streets we shall have held a local economic development summit. Already sectoral and build up summits on retail development; skills development; Agriculture; Tourism; Waste Management and Sport Development have been held bringing together ideas of experts and interested groups on how best we can together move beyond rhetoric and grow the local economy.

We have said, and will continue to say, that with some focus and collaborations Blouberg has all it takes to move out of its economic inactivity. Blouberg is an economic sleeping giant. What with its inspirational vision A participatory Municipality that turns prevailing challenges into opportunities for growth and development through optimal utilization of available resources. We do not want to steal the Summit's thunder, but we put our fingers crossed that

the Summit will resolve on strategies to exploit waste management for creation of sustainable jobs in every village; strategies to built sport facilities and expose boxing and football talents that are a common phenomena in Blouberg. Every willing person can, with some help, become his own pay master by optimally exploiting his God given talents. In the next few years Blouberg should be having a couple of boxing and football facilities of professional standards. However most of these would require our people to play their part, like paying for the services we provide them. Alldays and Senwabarwana towns account for the bigger part of our revenue base. You watch our next budget for the Medium Term Expenditure Framework period!

We have continued to excel in public participation programmes especially on the IDP and Budget. Though a few ward public meetings had to be postponed to later dates due to unforeseen circumstances, all wards shall speak on our 2009/2010 IDP and Budget. Thus far people have commonly recommended that we prioritise upgrading and maintenance of roads; culverts; and water provision. For the 2009/10 the following projects are already under way: tarring of internal streets of Puraspan, Witten, Alldays and upgrading of Eldorado sports complex.

In 2010/11 we construct Senwabarwana Traffic Station, Eldorado Satellite Office, and tarring of Senwabarwana Extension 1 Streets. In the next edition we will outline our build up plans for the 2010 FIFA World Cup. The people of Blouberg are not only interested in watching this historic event unfolding before them, they must benefit! May we take this opportunity to officially welcome the additional areas redermarcated into our municipal area. These include Tolwe; Vivo and a couple of farms, from Lephalale and Makhado municipalities respectively. In terms of the law the effective date of these redermacations is the 1st July 2009. Plans are underway to open a satellite office at Tolwe to provide a cost effective service in this far flung area. In the same breath we bid farewell to Ngwanallela Village which goes into the Aganang Municipality. We heartily thank all the people who contributed to the building of the Matladi house at Marobyane - the Trouble Shooting Team; Kgoshi Seakamela; civic structures and individual members of the public, no amount of voluntary contribution is insignificant. May God bless you.

# ADMINISTRATIVE OVERVIEW

We have just gone past the hundred days mark since the change of the political leadership of the Municipality in November 2008. Notwithstanding the fact that we did not conduct change management sessions our employees meticulously handled and successfully managed the transition.

This explains the level of maturity and understanding of the role of our administration, which is to implement plans and programmes of the Council. Administration is and should remain an apolitical component of the Municipality that executes the decisions of the Council and impartially serves the interests of the community.

We salute our officials and general workers who have continued to excel in their work and project our Administration in positive ways.

Employees who remain committed to their work and respect all the rules and code of conduct of the work place have their stay at the Municipality guaranteed in spite of changes that may be necessitated by changes in the political component of the Municipality. The rules of the game have not changed. We would continue to encourage and appeal for discipline and good conduct that is compatible with regulations applicable to the local government sector.

It is important to clarify some of the critical issues that continue to taint our Administration. The ugliest of them all is the notion that the Municipality lost R7m meant for electrification of villages in the 2006/2007 financial year. This is not true. This matter was explained and clarified a couple of times. The fact is - the money was temporarily withdrawn in the name of good financial management by the Department of Minerals and Energy (DME) and was regazetted in the 2008/9 financial year.

The money has been used to electrify villages such as New Jerusalem, Thabananthlana, Dithabaneng, Aurora etc.

Other villages like Nailana and Mochemi could not be electrified in 2008/9 due the insufficiency of our own revenue as we are expected to augment each cent from the DME. An arrangement was made with the DME for the money allocated for the 2008/9 of approximately R5 million to be used to construct feeder lines so that most of the above newly electrified villages may not wait long before they could be energised. Indeed contractors have been appointed to construct such feeder lines and the villages will hopefully be energised before the end of the current financial year.

We wish to reiterate that our Technical Department is doing everything possible to attend to all water problems subsequent to the delegation of water provision functions to us by Capricorn District Municipality (CDM). We appeal to communities to report water problems on time to expedite the purchase of the necessary materials and equipment.

Other avenues have also been exploited to alleviate water shortage within the Municipality. Recently three water tankers have been purchased and given to the Municipality by the CDM. The Municipality has also ordered more than 20 jojo tanks that will be put at strategic areas within villages that are hard hit by water shortage.

We have recently been joined by Mr Mphago M.J and Ms and Flora Rankweteke who used to play an active role as coordinators of the sport mass participation programme. Mr Mphago, commonly known as Moshaena, is now employed as a Traffic officer while Flora is a general worker. We have also been joined by Ms Betty Tlhabani (MIG Project Manager); Mr Mogano M.J (the MIG Technician); Boloka D.M (Traffic Officer); Mashiloane F.A (Examiner); Mathiane M.P (Cashier) and Lindeque A.F (Cashier). We welcome the staff members expecting them to add value and enhance service delivery. Kodumela!!!

"Now that he is in charge of the whole Municipality we are going to be exposed to his multi dimensional skills and abilities and we will all benefit," said Kgoshi Mamadi.

On behalf of CONTRALESA Blouberg, Kgoshi Mamadi promised the new Mayor all the support from the traditional authorities and wished him well in his daunting mandate.

The Mayor/Magoshi Forum has since held its first meeting with the new Mayor on the 26th February 2009, where they considered, among an array of issues, reports on status of housing projects in the whole municipal area; Notice of land development area application in respect of the Portion of Bochum 178 LS Farm; Development of Senwabarwana Township; the Desmond Park Housing Project; celebration of the rich culture and heritage characterising Blouberg Municipality; and their future meetings arrangements.

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# RATANANG SPECIAL SCHOOL CONQUERS THE WORLD

**B**louberg has always been a home to talent. The Mayor, Councillor Serite Sekgoloane, has always said that we can beat poverty and unemployment if we unearth and develop all the sporting talents that every Blouberg kids naturally have.

A new talent was unearthed in Blouberg as 8 athletes from the Ratanang Special School in Senwabarwana formed part of the South African team that participated in the Special Olympic World Winter Games (SOWWG) in the United State of America against 65 other countries of the world. On its first attempt after Floor Hockey had been introduced fifteen years ago, the new kids on the block from Blouberg walked away with gold medals, having played 12 games, winning 9, drawing 1 and losing 2. Out of 14 divisions from 66 countries, the South African team was placed on Division 5 playing with four countries. The "underdog's team" as they were affectionately known were awarded Gold Medals for obtaining first position which is the first ever special Olympics South African Floor Hockey Gold medal from international / World Winter Games. The team left Idaho, USA on the 14th of February 2009 and landed in South Africa on the 16th of February 2009. Blouberg Mayor Cllr Serite Sekgoloane was among those waiting with enthusiasm and pride for the team at Ratanang School.

The man behind all this achievement, Mr Matshwenyego Dzumba, started coaching at Ratanang Special School eight years ago on a voluntary basis. He was later absorbed as an additional staff member of the school in 2004 on a temporary basis. Dzumba holds a coaching certificate in Special Olympics which includes sporting codes like Floor Hockey, Athletics and Bocce.

In Limpopo only two District municipalities participate in special games: Vhembe and Capricorn District. Ratang also competes at national levels. Dzumba highlighted lack of facilities and equipments as their major challenge. "We don't have a hall and the poles for floor hockey. It is difficult for us to do proper training, and for attire we borrow from the national office," says Dzumba. He says they are now preparing themselves for the Provincial Summer Games to be held in September 2009 that will be followed by National Summer Games to be held in September 2010.

These are preparations for the International Summer Games to be held in Greece, Athens in September 2011. Dzumba has thanked Blouberg Mayor Cllr Serite Sekgoloane for his inspiration and passion about sport in the Blouberg area. "He is so passionate about developing sport in our area that he is an inspiration to young people," says Dzumba.

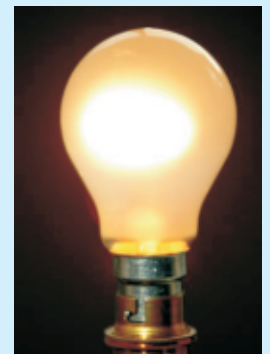

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## BLOUBERG BREAKS NEW GROUNDS WITH ITS INCLUSIONARY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Gone are those days where development was not sustainable and people had to be separated in terms of race, colour, ethnicity, religion and mainly class. The Limpopo Provincial Government launched its first Breaking New Ground project with the provision of low cost housing in Bendor in the Polokwane Municipality. Blouberg follows suit by becoming the second Municipality in the Limpopo Province to implement its settlement development project the Breaking New Ground way.

### What is a Breaking New Ground Project?

This refers to an integrated human settlement which ensures that there is sustainability of a settlement by incorporating various classes of people within one locality and also including various land uses that bring economic development in a locality. The process started with the Economic Development and Planning Department of the Blouberg Municipality making numerous requests for financial assistance to the Department of Local Government and Housing to make funds available for the finalisation of the process of township establishment, servicing of sites and the provision of low cost housing for 30% of the demarcated ervens.

The project involves the township establishment at Senwabarwana extension 5 through the Development Facilitation Act. A total of 1004 ervens are being demarcated, serviced through the provision of water and

sewer reticulation as well as basic road infrastructure.

Within those 1004 ervens there are ervens for business development, public open spaces for park development, ervens for schools and churches, as well as light industrial sites. Local business people are targeted for such business and industrial ervens. We are moving towards a classless society where the issue of segregation on the basis of socio-economic class will be a thing of the past, thus entrenching the spirit of Ubuntu amongst our people.

Targeted groups will include but not limited to the following:

- National imperatives on who qualifies will be followed, e.g persons whose monthly earnings do not exceed R3500
- Priority will be given to residents in Desmond Park who were approved for low cost housing but did not have sites where such houses were to be constructed
- Priority will further be given to Blouberg residents who meet the above first criteria (earning below R3500-with proof of income from their employers) who are employed in establishments around the town of Senwabarwana. ## DEVILLIERSDALE HOSTS THE MAYOR'S IMBIZO

Blouberg Local Municipality Mayor Cllr Serite Sekgoloane has urged Blouberg citizens not to lose hope in the government of the day. Cllr Sekgoloane was reacting to grievances mainly concerning water shortage and electricity raised by residents of Devilliersdale in ward 04 during the Mayor's Imbizo that was coupled with an IDP Ward Public Meeting. The Municipality hosts Izimbizos as part of its programme of enhancing community participation. This was the second of the two major Imbizos the Municipality has planned for the 2008/2009 financial with the first having taken place at Ga - Hlako in November 2008.

Electricity, water provision and lack of poverty alleviation programmes were the main issues raised by the residents of Devilliersdale during the Imbizo held at Devilliersdale sport ground on Saturday, the 7th March 2009. The mayor's visit to the area was to find out the challenges the people of Devilliersdale and the surrounding villages were facing on daily basis and to brief them about the progress as to how far the Municipality is in terms of delivering services in their

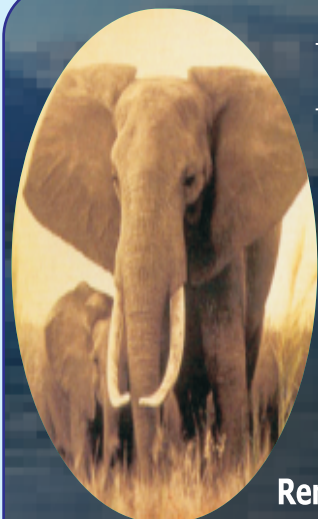

respective areas. While addressing the gathering Cllr Sekgoloane said Capricorn District Municipality has injected funds in water projects to fast track the process of water provision in the rural Blouberg. Meanwhile the Department of Minerals and Energy has allocated Blouberg Local Municipality over R10 million for electrification of DeVilliersdale, Vienna, Morale, Nailana, Mochemi, Kgware, Mashamaite, Hlako B, La-Rochelle, OldLong Signe and Raweshi in the financial year 2009/2010. Cllr Sekgoloane said ward 04 as hard hit by poverty need special service delivery interventions.

He said in terms of the millennium development goals all villages must have access to electricity and free basic services by 2012.

In conjunction with the South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) the Mayor gave truck loads of food parcels to needy households, promising that the giving of food parcels would continue as long as there are families who go to bed on empty stomachs.



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# ROAD D1468 GOES TAR

Blouberg Municipality Mayor, His Worship Cllr Serite Sekgoloane, has officially launched the project: Upgrading of Road D1468, (gravel to tar) that will link Senwabarwana, Indermark and Vivo. Scores of people from the surrounding villages; Marobyane, Indermark, Ga-Machaba and Ga-Marais converged at Ga-Machaba village on Monday, 09 February 2009, to witness what they call "real service delivery". Cllr Sekgoloane officially handed over the site to the contractors by conducting a sod turning ceremony. This R57 million project is set to boost the local economic development initiatives by creating employment to locals. The 25 kilometer road is expected to be complete by mid-2010.

Mr Mabeso started out as a goalkeeper en route to professional ranks. He started for Kwena Moloto College of

Education in the Inter- College Games in the early eighties and was snapped by the erstwhile scout, Joseph Search Nkoane, for trials with Mamelodi United. A broken leg in one of the trial matches put paid to "Bhakino,"s promising football career.

In 1993 he founded and became a Managing Director of Kibi Trio Stars, a football club that came to make the name Kibi synonymous with football in the erstwhile Far North Football Association (FNFA).

It was not an ordinary football club but a professionally run outfit, with a club house; a team bus and some full time players. This was an amateur team that hosted and played against professional sides such as Dynamos (1996); Ria Stars (1996); and Mapate Silver Stars, your today's Platinum Stars (1996), a year after it reached the last 64 of the national Bob Save Superbowl Competitions.

Mr Mabeso boast of formal coaching fundamentals having attended, among the many coaching lessons, a course conducted by the then national Director of Coaching, Mr Ted Dumitru. Mabeso prides himself in having had a hand in the unearthing of the hidden talents of the late Lesley Manyethela from Musina who eventually played for Orlando Pirates and Selaelo "Trompies" Maputla from Kromhoek (Ga

Makgato), currently playing for the National First Division side, Black Leopards.

In 2002 Mr Mabeso traveled as a guest of the national team, Bafana Bafana, to Chichiri Stadium in Malawi for their world cup qualifier. He had been chosen to represent the FNFA in recognition and honour of his immense contribution to the growth and development of football in the far flung northern tip of the country.



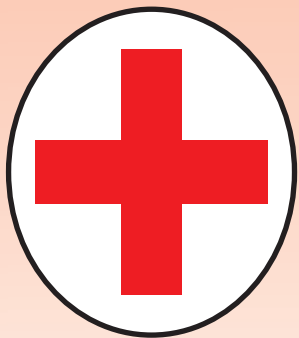
