Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 49(1)(a)(i) of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act (Act No. 6 of 2004), hereinafter referred to as the "Act", that the General valuation roll for the financial years 2023 to 2028 is open for public inspection at the offices of the Blouberg Local Municipality from 02 February 2023 to 31 March 2023, Civic Centre 2nd Building, Mogwadi/ Senwabarwana Roadas, Senwabarwana, as well as on the municipal website www.blouberg.gov.za

An invitation is hereby made in terms of Section 49(1)(a)(ii) of the Act that property owner of rateable property, or other person who so desires, are invited to lodge an objection with the Municipal Manager in respect of any matter recorded or omitted in the General valuation roll as contemplated in the Act. Any objections must be lodged within the said period above.

Attention is specifically drawn to the fact that in terms of Section 50(2) of the Act an objection must be in relation to a specific individual property and not against the valuation roll as such. The form prescribed for the lodging of any objection is obtainable at the address indicated below or the municipal website www.blouberg.gov.za.

The Municipal Manager will assist any person/s who cannot read or write to lodge an objection as contemplated in the Act.

The prescribed forms for lodging of an objections are obtainable at the following municipal offices: Civic centre, Aildays Satellite Office, Eldorado Satellite Office, langlaagte Satellite Office, Inveraan Satellite Office, Harriswish Satellite Office and Tolwe Satellite Office.
