MAYOR ADRESSES COUNCIL REGARDING PROGRESS ON DEVELOPMENT DURING SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

The Council of Blouberg Local Municipality led by its chairperson, the Speaker Cllr Blanco Boloka today had a Special Council sitting in Senwabarwana. The meeting was to deal with urgent reports for Council approval to ensure that service delivery is not hampered.
