

MAYOR'S STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS CONTINUE

Today, Blouberg Local Municipality Mayor visited Kgoshi Maleboho NI as part of her stakeholder engagement programme.

Her Worship, Cllr Maria Thamaga kicked off her meet and greet sessions yesterday to introduce the new leadership to various municipal stakeholders, with first session, being dedicated to traditional authorities.
