BLOUBERG MUNICIPALITY LEADERSHIP MONITOR COMPLIANCE DURING LOCKDOWN

Blouberg Local Municipality leadership, Mayor, His Worship Cllr Maseka Pheedi, Speaker Cllr Maria Thamaga and members of the Executive Committee (EXCO), Senwabarwana SAPS, BLM Traffic Services Disaster Management officials joined by Member of the Provincial Legislature (MPL) Ms Monicca Mochadi were hard at work in Senwabarwana Town yesterday (1/4/20) monitoring among others ; the queues to SASSA pay points, supermarkets, banks, and other shops classified under essential services to insure that there is compliance in terms of measures put in place by government to curb COVID-19 spread.

The President of the Republic, His Excellency Cyril Ramaphosa on the 15th of May 2020, declared COVID-19 a national disaster in terms of Disaster Management Act. This was followed by a number of precautionary measures put in place to slow the spread of the virus.

The leadership also offered basic education on novel coronavirus and how to prevent the spread by practicing social distancing, frequent washing of hands with water and soap or sanitizers, elbow greetings and avoiding of crowded places among other things.

Mayor Pheedi and MPL Mochadi also visited Ratshaatsha Community Health Centre and Manabalala Shopping Complex at Eldorado Village to monitor COVID-19 protocol compliance and conscientize community members about the virus.
