BLOUBERG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY ACHIEVES UNQUALIFIED AUDIT OPINION FOR 2019/20 FINANCIAL YEAR

The Blouberg Local Municipality has received an unqualified audit opinion for the 2019/20 financial year from the Auditor-General of South Africa (AGSA).

The Auditor-General of South Africa (AGSA) represented by Senior Manager, Ms Molatelo Magongwa, on the 28th April 2021 presented the 2019/20 audit outcomes for the municipality during an Ordinary Council Meeting held earlier in Senwabarwana.

An unqualified opinion is defined as an auditor's opinion that; the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the municipality as at 30 June 2020, and it's financial performance and cash flows of the year ended in accordance with the Standards of GenerallyRecognized Accounting Practice (Standard GRAP) and requirements of the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA) of South Africa. Act 56 of 2003 (MFMA) and the Division of Revenue Act 16 of 2019 (Dora).

Mayor Pheedi has welcomed the report and commended the council and the administration of Blouberg Local Municipalityled by Municipal Manager, Mr Junias Machaba for the hard work and efforts they undergo to provide communities with the reassurance that their money is being spent as it should.
