The SDBIP is developed in compliance with the requirements of the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA). The plan enables management, the Executive Committee and the Council to monitor the implementation of the Integrated Development Plan (IDP)/ Budget on monthly, quarterly, half-yearly and annual basis.

The 2-day session will conclude tommorow (23 April) with resolutions on how to fast track the delivery of services to communities.
